LABOR DAY IN STYLE

Humboldt braces for its grandest Labor Day yet, drawing over 1,000 eager excursionists on September 2nd. Committees tirelessly orchestrate every detail, guaranteeing a resounding success. A thrilling \$500 baseball tournament headlines the festivities, complemented by a lively \$250 rock drilling contest and a heart-pounding half-mile horse race offering \$200. Bronco busting, rousing tug-of-war, and a variety of other athletic events fuel the day's merriment.

From the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, *Arizona's Country Town*, the Fenn family welcomes you to the Agua Fria Festival! Not only known for being the gateway to the Prescott area, Dewey and Humboldt are a big part of Arizona's rich mining history.

A necessity for the miners, the farming town of Dewey was settled in 1863 by pioneer prospector, rancher, and politician King Woolsey. Neighbored by Humboldt, originally named Val Verde, was built on the mining and processing of ore at the smelters constructed in mid-1870 and 1899.

Born and raised in the area, I spent most of my time in Walker where much of this history started. My family, wife Kendall and kids Karina (12) and Winston (7), live on our ranch in Dewey where we built a niche market breeding horses from South America. Involved in many aspects of the agricultural industry, more recently we have been busy sharing our western way of life with guests and students.

Signs of the past can still be seen today. From the ruins of Fort Woolsey to numerous mine relics all around the Bradshaw mountains, I encourage you to explore the area and see Arizona's heritage firsthand.
